6. Sharing and Farewell:

• The stay concluded with oral presentations and an emotional goodbye before the Italian students departed for Parma.

Added value of the partners:

- The Nantes FABLAB "PING Hyperlink" was a real catalyst for learning, offering students the opportunity to create and innovate using a variety of technologies.
- The Maison des Hommes et des Techniques de Nantes enriched the experience with immersive artistic activities, stimulating students' creativity and personal expression.
- The Institut Universitaire de Technologie (IUT) Nantes Carquefou also made a significant contribution by organizing advanced workshops in welding, Python programming and the creation of innovative technological projects.

TWINSPACE digital platform:

All these experiences were shared on the European digital platform TWINSPACE, strengthening the links between our schools and enabling the continuous sharing of educational content.

This project, carried out entirely in English and cofinanced by European Union funds dedicated to education and international mobility (Erasmus+), was a fundamental experience for our students and the educational team.
